The Railroad Machinist position performs all mechanical work on rail car and non-revenue equipment, parts production and repair. Must be available to work full-time (40 hrs/week) subject to overtime, on-call (24/7), alternating shifts, nights, weekends, and holidays. Potential relocation benefits are negotiable.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Operates various types of machines such as lathes, shapers, milling machines, boring mills, radial and stationary drill presses and other machines. (Manual machine work)
- Sets up and aligns work so that new or used parts of accessory equipment may be machined for proper setting and reassembling.

- Performs precision bench layout, assembly, repair and maintenance work on shop machinery and tools to keep them in proper working condition.
- Inspects various components and housing apparatus for leaks, cracks, wear and tension.
- Reads and interprets diagrams, schematics, blueprints, sketches, bulletins and other materials necessary to perform assigned maintenance functions.
- Reports to the Master Mechanic on any unsafe practices and/or working conditions existing in the work area.
- Performs related duties as assigned.
- Complete authorized repairs and document outcomes of all repair activities
- Follow company and federal rules, policies, and procedures – wear required safety equipment, respond to and act on safety concerns

**Education and/or Experience Requirements:**

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Required to possess a minimum of five years verifiable experience as a machinist in a recognized machine shop or educational equivalent.
- Must pass all required assessments/trainings and be willing to submit to a background check, pre-employment drug screen, and random drug tests
- High School diploma (or equivalent) and previous experience in the railroad or heavy construction or maintenance industry is preferred, but not required
- Work in all weather conditions (extreme hot, cold, rain, snow, sleet, etc.)
- Understand and follow verbal/visual communications; respond to audible and visual signals and warnings; recognize, avoid and report potential hazards
- Interact effectively as a team member and be capable of working unsupervised at times
- Must be okay with fitting in tight spaces
- Required to furnish the essential hand tools used on this job
- Physical ability to stand; walk; sit; use hands; talk or hear; climb stairs and/or ladders; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl; lift and/or move up to 100 pounds; ability to use close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and adjust focus
